e.g. <u>colon to introduce a list</u>

2008 was the best year ever: 86% of pupils achieved 5 A-Cs at GCSE.

<u>semi-colon to separate items in a list when the items are longer phrases.</u> The team included the following players: Emma Smith, highest goal scorer of the season; Tanya Reilly, reserve goal keeper; and Mary Munroe, a very effective captain.
