Last Day of The School Year

I would like to remind parents and carers that the last day of the academic year is Thursday 25th July. The school will close early on this day at 12:30pm to enable staff to finalise administrative duties and clear rooms before a summer deep clean takes place. September Uniform Policy Change Reminder

I would like to remind parents and carers that from this September, all student skirts in Years 7 to 11 must be pleated. This is to enable parents and carers to plan early for this change. Please note that:

- Skirts must be black, of a formal cut and wide pleated.
- Pencil style/tight fitting/stretch material skirts are not permitted.
- Skirts should be worn at the waist and with appropriate regard to a formal appearance.
- Hems should be no more than 5cm above the knee
- Fashion belts are not allowed
