## Post Celebration Day Timetable

I am writing to you to explain the school arrangements for Year 11 students during their exam period.

On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May, we will be celebrating the Class of 2019! Pupils are welcome to come in 'appropriate Fancy Dress' for the day. There will be a Celebration assembly in the morning followed by a BBQ at lunchtime. Please note that any accessories that could be considered inappropriate will not be allowed on the day. This includes toy weapons and guns etc.

The main written GCSE exams start on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May. Please take time to log onto INSIGHT to check over your child's exam timetable and ensure that they are prepared and have the correct equipment for their exams. Pupils need to make sure that they arrive promptly to their exams and attend warm up sessions beforehand. There is a copy of the exam timetable on the school website and a detailed warm-up schedule will be issued very soon.

For all of the GCSE examinations, it is an expectation that all pupils arrive in <u>full school uniform</u> and will still be required to stay on the school site at all times during the school day. If the exam has already taken place in a subject, then pupils must bring their own revision for quiet study and exam preparation in those lessons. Shirt signing for our pupils will take place on the 9<sup>th</sup> May period 7 (2.10-3.00pm). <u>Please ensure that pupils still do have shirts to wear for their examinations before they leave.</u>

Pupils will be expected to attend all lessons up until the 14<sup>th</sup> June. After this point, they are still required to attend lessons that they still have an exam in otherwise they will be free to study at home and leave after they have completed exams. This is with the exception of BTEC lessons which will continue until the students have completed the coursework to the required standard. There will be an allocated quiet study room timetabled if pupils choose to study in school between exams and revision sessions.
