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Why do an apprenticeship?

- Some high quality apprenticeships available.
- Earn money whilst you learn.
- No debt
- Guaranteed a job at the end of the training.
- Employers like to mentor young people to develop their own talent.
- Higher level/degree apprenticeships are an excellent alternative to University.
- Available to 18-24 year olds!



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Update on Apprenticeships

- The Government are encouraging more companies to offer apprenticeships. They are doing this via the Apprenticeship Levy.
- There is a drive to make available more higher level apprenticeships particularly Higher/Degree Level 6 apprenticeships.
- Degree level apprenticeships should start to appear on the UCAS website.

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Apprenticeship Levy

What is it?

With effect from April 2017 all large employers with a wage bill larger than £3m per year will have to pay a 0.5% levy to the Government.

Why?

This action is being taken to increase the number of apprenticeships on offer by 3 million by 2020.

Will Employers get this money back?

Yes if they recruit apprentices within 18 months of paying the levy. They can reclaim the money in digital vouchers to pay for the training of apprentices. If they don't claim, it during this time, it is lost!

Do the Government make a contribution?

Yes, they will contribute 10% as a top up to the employer's fund.
