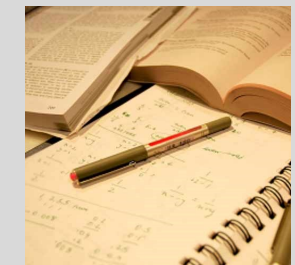
## YEAR 10

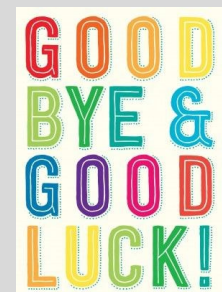
## YEAR 11

Apart from a few final exams to run next week, the majority of Year 11 have now finished their journey at Toot Hill.

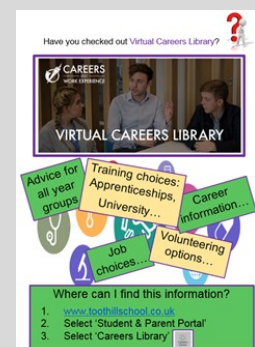
